VANCOUVER – Minister of Small Business and Economic Development John Les and the Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (CME) today announced **BC's Top 21 Exporters for 2004**.

These 21 award finalists will be honoured by fellow exporters, business leaders, and government officials at the **2004 BC Export Awards Gala Luncheon**, to be held at **1:00 p.m.** on **Friday, Nov. 19** at the Sheraton Vancouver Wall Centre Hotel, 1088 Burrard St.

"The BC Export Awards recognize the province's very best exporters and highlight the export industry's vital contribution to the BC economy," said Minister Les. "This year, BC exports are enjoying double digit growth, and our Top 21 Exporters are a significant part of this success."
